- 1. The Aztecs ruled in present-day <u>Mexico City</u>, the capital of Mexico.
- 2. What Aztec ruins can you still see today, and where are they located?
 - a. Near the city center, there are remains of Aztecs buildings under the streets. These were discovered in 1978.
- 3. What was the name of the island where the nomadic people, the Aztecs, settled? a. Tenochtitlan
- 4. What happened when the Aztecs defeated other tribes?
 - a. They expected to get payments, or tributes, or else they would return.
- 5. Where was the main trading center of the Aztec empire?
 - a. The city of Tenochtitlan had a thriving market. Goods were traded from all over the empire.
- 6. Describe the Aztecs house.
 - a. There was a thatched house with a few simple things inside. On their land, maize was grown.
- 7. Maize is also known as <u>corn</u>, which was an important food for the Aztecs. They made <u>tortillas</u> from the corn.
- 8. Why were warriors important to the Aztec society?
 - a. They were important because they captured neighboring tribes and received more tributes. The more tributes a warrior got, the more important he became.
- 9. In the inner temple, what took place?
 - a. A special ceremony where they called upon the gods to bless the new warrior.
- 10. The Aztecs made human sacrifices to make sure the <u>sun</u> rose each day.
- 11. What type of economy do you think the Aztecs had? Explain why.
- 12. The Aztecs used <u>music and dance</u> to relive great moments in their history and to <u>communicate</u> with their gods.
